








MAP 1-1 JOURNEYS OF MARCO POLO AND IBN BATTUTA



















# Conclusions

- Ovarian cancer patients need more and specific information about side effects, studies, supportive care and second opinion options.
- This study underlines the high need of ovarian cancer patients to discuss all details concerning treatment options and clinical management.
- Alopecia and fatigue are the most important side effects bothering the patients.
- The physician is the most relevant source of information for patients.
- In this study, we have not observed any impact of age, profession or tumor stage on the results. The answers were in general similar across the countries.





- **EXPRESSION VIII:** Survey in patients with low grade ovarian cancer


