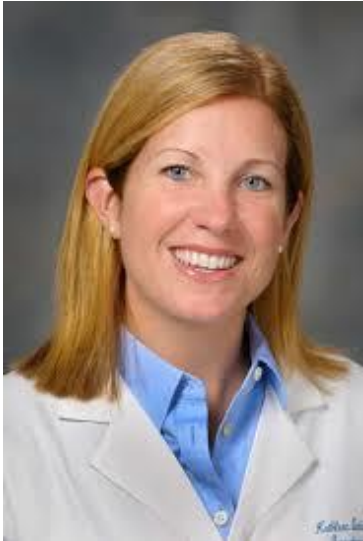
Global Curriculum and Mentorship Program

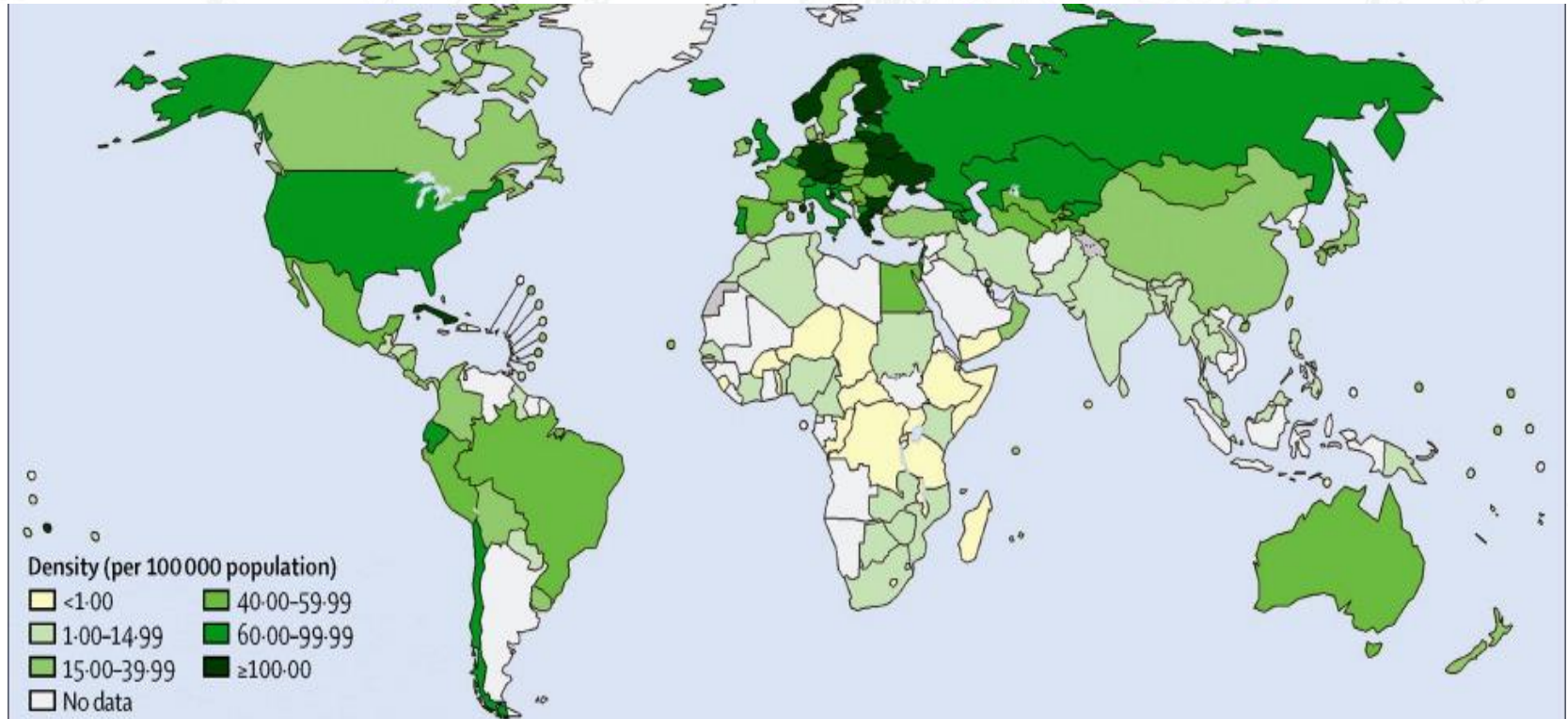

Background

- **There is a significant shortage of health care providers in regions of the world with high cervical cancer rates**
- **Many regions do not have specialty training in gynecologic oncology**
- **Critical need to train and educate local physicians to address the epidemic of rising rates of cancer globally, particularly in LMICs**

Global Curriculum & Mentorship Program

- **2 year Gynecologic Oncology training and education program for regions without formal training:**
 - **Web-based curriculum that can be modified by sites**
 - **Match institutions and individuals from programs in regions with formal Gynecologic Oncology training with partners in regions without (twinning)**
 - **Goal: train 1 to 2 fellows per year, in collaboration with local hospital, University and MoH**

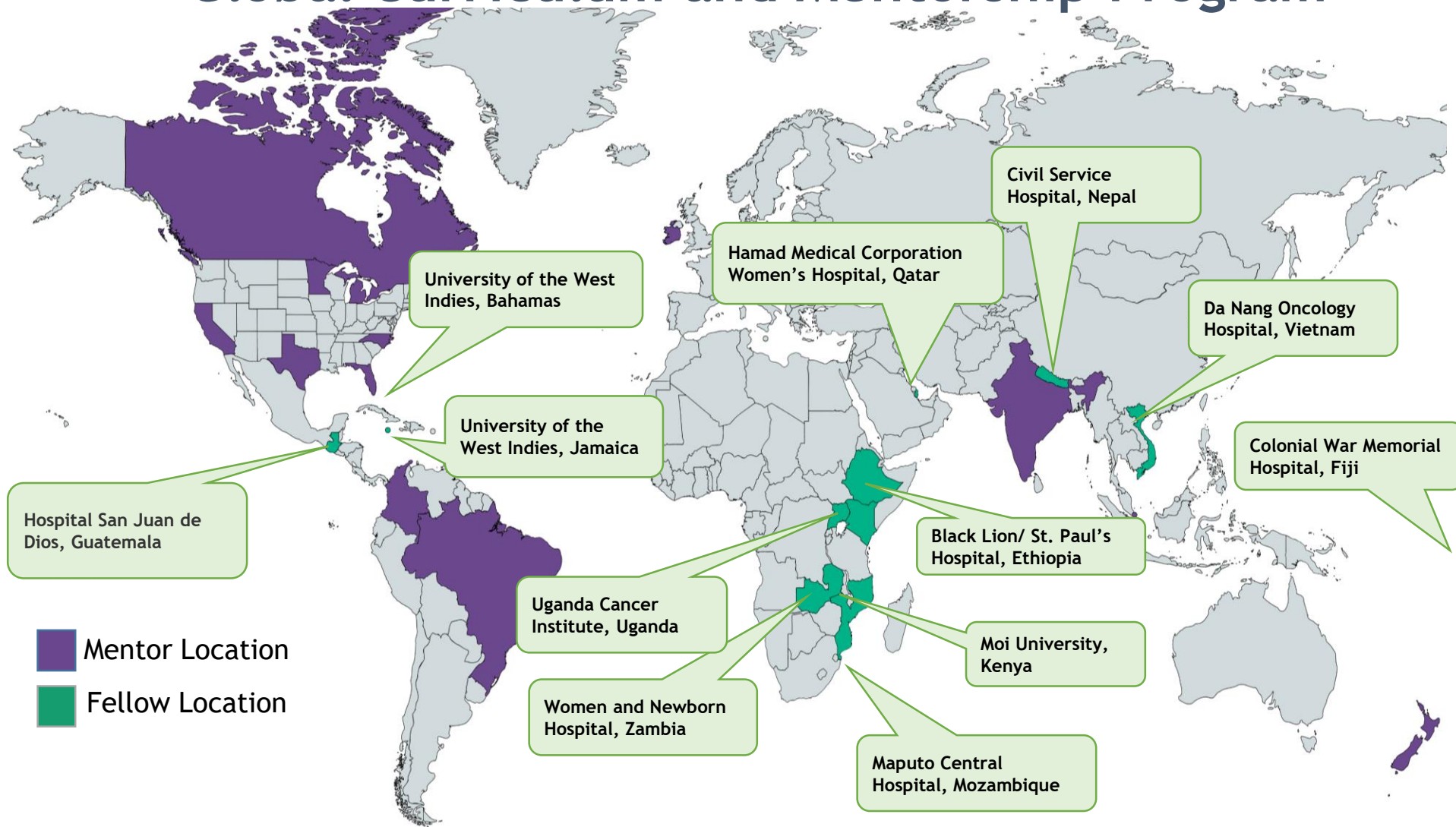
Global Curriculum & Mentorship Program

- Local mentor
- International mentor(s)
- Monthly meetings between fellow(s) and mentors
 - Review of curriculum (donated textbooks), Assessments
- Monthly tumor board (Project ECHO)

Global Curriculum & Mentorship Program

- International mentor(s) visits site minimum ≥ 2 x/year
- Fellow spends ~3 months at international mentoring site
- Final exam (written, oral and practical)
 - Exam committee led by Dr. Al Covens
- Certificate (not certification)

Global Curriculum and Mentorship Program



3 Month Observership

- **Fellow visits the international mentoring site**
- **Opportunity to gain additional exposure to:**
 - **Gynecologic Oncology Surgery**
 - **Radiation Oncology**
 - **Pathology**
 - **Multi-disciplinary care**
 - **Minimally invasive surgery**
 - **Research/Clinical Trials**

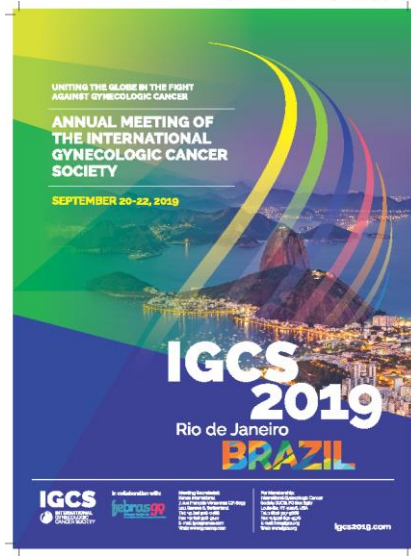

Project ECHO Virtual Tumor Board

- Occur monthly, M&M quarterly
- Last one hour
 - 40-45 minutes of case presentations
 - 15-20 minute didactic lecture
- Local providers present de-identified patient cases and receive feedback from international experts:
 - Gyn Onc
 - Gyn Pathology
 - Radiation Oncology
 - Palliative Care, Pediatric Oncology

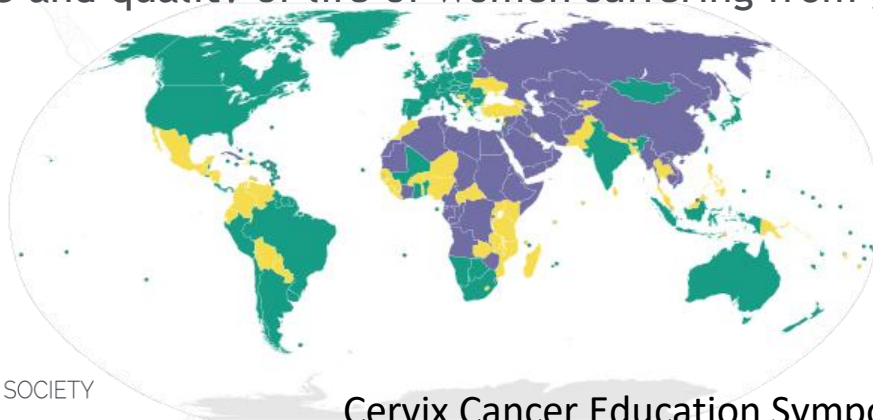

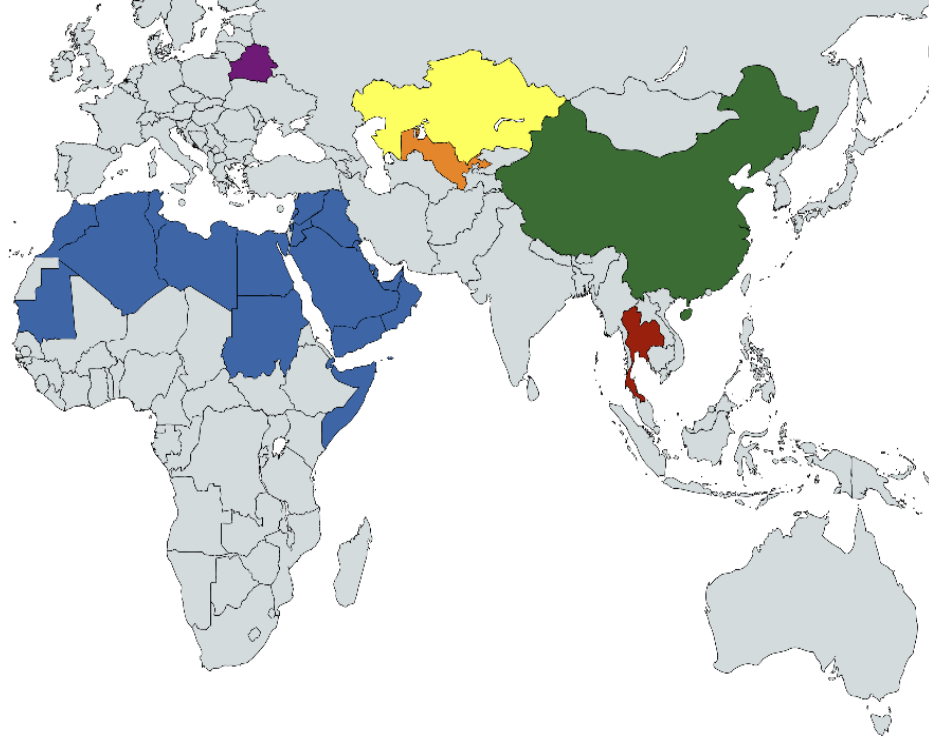
