- QOL analysis
- ITT and ineligible patients
- The timing of release of results
- PFS definition, censoring acceptability as primary end-point. Treatment interruptions and the duration of these, sensitivity analysis. SAP preparation if monitoring or partially unblinded
- Non-inferiority trials, design and analysis
- Randomized phase II

Before each group meeting one member prepares a presentation on a subject on the list. The list is also revised.

Topic Liverpool: Unblinding(Jim)
Topic Orlando: Non-inf analysis (Val)

We briefly discussed DMC charters, these should not be too restrictive but gyne specific. Discussion and adaptations should be conducted for each new charter. Val will give more input on this pending the release of the Australian guidelines.
