


CCRN SITE ASSESSMENT AND SELECTION: PROCESS


- 1. Site Referral from a GCIG Group leading a CCRN Trial
- 2. CCRN Chair approves the initiation of the site assessment and selection according to the Standard Operating Procedure (CCRN-SOP-01 v2.0)



CCRN SITE ASSESSMENT AND SELECTION: PROCESS (cont.)


3. Capability Questions:

- CCRN Site Pre-Qualifying Questionnaire (PQQ)
 - ✓ General Site Information
 - ✓ Investigator and Staff Qualifications/Site Experience
 - ✓ Study Populations and Accrual Goals
 - ✓ Site Resources



CCRN SITE ASSESSMENT AND SELECTION: PROCESS (cont.)


- 3. Capability Questions (cont.):
 - ✓ GCIG Study
 - ✓ Regulatory, Insurance/Indemnification
 - > RPC Facility Questionnaire
 - Web-based questionnaire
 - Demographics and technical Survey



CCRN SITE ASSESSMENT AND SELECTION: PROCESS (cont.)

4. Site Evaluation Visit:

- meeting with the potential Investigator at his/her Institution
- tour of the facility
- discuss the fundamentals of the protocol and how that relates to the feasibility of recruiting potential participants



CCRN SITE ASSESSMENT AND SELECTION: PROCESS (cont.)

5. Site Activation

 CCRN Chair will send a follow-up letter to the investigator, summarizing the results of the Site Evaluation visit and action items if applicable and communicating the final decision if the site is approved or not.
